## Kingston's Community Beautification Committee Keeping Kingston Gorgeous!

The Kingston Beautification Committee is comprised of a dedicated group of volunteers who are not afraid of a little dirt and hard work! This is the group to be thanked for, among other things, the beautiful hanging flower baskets that adorn the downtown area light poles from early spring to late fall. This is no small task, as the baskets are heavy and the poles are far from the ground. Once in place, the plants need to be watered every day. It takes a couple of hours to ride around town in the Port of Kingston's Gator outfitted with a huge water tank and 8 foot wand. Team work is the key to success. Each winter the CBC collects greens and then gather at the Port of Kingston to assemble festive cedar swags, each sporting a big red bow, and they're off again to decorate the light poles. They organize the annual town clean-ups. Perhaps you've seen the orange vested gals picking up trash and smiling all the while. Not exactly what you might expect from trash collectors but this committee consistently exceeds expectations and does so generously, to improve the quality of life for the community that they love!

Gail Halsaver has chaired this group for years and provides the flower baskets. She and her husband, Dave, have been growing beautiful perennials at Foxglove Greenhouses in Hansville since 2000 and before that in Poulsbo. Although mainly a wholesale operation selling to 40 Western WA nurseries, they are open to the public on Saturdays, spring through fall, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., and other days by appointment. They grow a wide selection of unusual annuals, tropicals, tomatoes, container plants (more than 3 dozen varieties) and both hard-to-find and main-stay perennials.
